
Recommended TAC (Total Allowable Catch, or quota) of legal-sized individuals (0 mm) :

Fresh/wet products	0.015 t
Salted and gutted products	0.007 t
Dried products (bêche-de-mer)	0.001 t

Important note -The estimates above incorporate measure uncertainty and are conservative.

There are too few transects in the selected zones to accurately calculate estimate uncertainty due to the heterogeneous spatial distribution of the resources over the study site. It is therefore suggested to perform the statistical analysis using a larger sample size, i.e., including more habitat zones. Assessment results are available in the CSV files. Great care should be taken to avoid misinterpretation given the above statistical issue.

Legal-sized individuals (0 mm) represent **100 % of the total stock biomass**. This high proportion means that small individuals were rarely observed during survey compared to large individuals, and may be indicative of recruitment failure. **Consequently, it is recommended to cut the estimated TAC (see table) by 50 % as a precautionary approach.**
